ST. JOHN'S COLLEGE HONOUR J / EAGLE AWARD APPLICATION

CRITERIA:

1. Assigned points for areas of involvement **MUST** be assigned by the appropriate staff advisor/supervisor and confirmed with a signature. If advisor/supervisor is no longer available, then print their name.
2. The application form must be returned to STUDENT SERVICES OFFICE by April 30th.
3. Points can be earned at any time during your first four years at St. John's College.
4. You must earn at least the minimum number of points in Academics and at least two of the five optional categories of school and community life. Additional points may be earned from any/all categories. **Letter of Reference must be included**
5. As a general guideline, each point awarded represents about 10 hours of involvement, as well as level of commitment and overall contribution to the group.
6. The points you see in the "Points per Year" column are maximum numbers.
7. During the student's years at St. John's College, he/she must have behaved according to the Code of Expectations as indicated in the school's Code of Human Relations. (I.e. Having had no serious or on-going violations of the Code)
8. 40 hours of community work **CANNOT** be included. Hours accumulated above the 40 hours required for the OSSD may be applied towards the Eagle and Honour J Awards if they were done at a St. John's College sponsored activity.
