Top feedback 'themes' that we heard are important to you:

- School Safety
- Mental Health and Well-Being
- Educational Needs of Students

Actions taken as a result of your survey feedback:

- Increased involvement between School Resource Officer, Staff and Students.
- Classroom visits by Administration and School Resource Officer to discuss safety concerns.
- The development of a School Wellness Committee to support Mental Health.
- Students having greater access to counselling with a full time social worker on staff.
- Greater access to school Library before school and during lunches.
- Pathways Committee and Guidance to work closely with students to assist them in career planning and post secondary options.
