REGISTRATION, HONOUR ROLL & ONTARIO SCHOLAR CRITERIA

- **Registration:** You should have already registered to graduate with your Guidance Counsellor. This information is important as we must order a diploma for you from the Ministry of Education.
- **Principal's Honour Roll Criteria:** Gr. 12 students who qualify for this must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 courses and must achieve a minimum overall average of 80%. These courses must be taken in the traditional classroom setting, during day school at St. John's College in the current academic year. One course in Religion must also be taken as part of this complement.
- **Ontario Scholar Criteria:** A student who obtains a total of at least 480 marks in any combination of Ministry approved Gr. 12 courses having a total of 6 credits, and who has been recommended by the Principal for the Ontario Secondary School Diploma in either the current school year or the previous school year, may be designated as an Ontario Scholar.

HONOUR J & EAGLE AWARD

- The **Honour J Award** is presented to graduates for outstanding achievement and total involvement adding excellence to several programs within school life.
