Graduation Rehearsal

The graduation rehearsal will take place Wednesday June 26, 2019 at the Sanderson Centre. Rehearsal will begin at 9:00 am sharp and finish at 12:00 pm. ALL GRADS PARTICIPATING IN THE CEREMONY MUST ATTEND THE REHEARSAL. You will have to pay for parking on the street or in the municipal lots, so don't forget your change. NO FOOD OR DRINK IS PERMITTED IN THE SANDERSON CENTRE. PLEASE RESPECT THESE RULES.

Graduation Ceremony

The Graduation Ceremony will be held at the Sanderson Centre on Thursday June 27, 2019 at 7:00 pm. Graduates must be at the Sanderson by 6:00 pm, in order to be fitted with a gown, stole and assemble in alphabetical order. To be admitted to the Sanderson you must show your WHITE PASS at the 1st General Admission Entrance Door on Darling Street. Upon arrival please go to the Rehearsal Room immediately, sign in, pick up your gown and stole. Girls should wear a dress, or a blouse with a skirt or pants and dress shoes. Boys should wear a white dress shirt and tie, dress pants and dress shoes. All graduation gowns and stoles must be returned immediately following the ceremony. If gowns and/or stoles are not returned a charge of \$100.00 will be billed to you. Remember to take photos before you return the gown to the Green Room. DO NOT BRING VALUABLES TO THE SANDERSON CENTRE DURING REHEARSAL OR THE CEREMONY AS THEY CANNOT BE LOCKED UP.

***** PLEASE NOTE *****

Students must show their WHITE PASS and guests must show their EMBOSSED GREEN PASS to be admitted to the Sanderson Centre. Due to the large graduating class the number of Guest Passes have been limited to THREE unless you have received an additional guest pass through the lottery process. This meets the maximum number of people allowed in the Sanderson Centre under FIRE REGULATIONS. This is the reason guests will not be admitted without a pass and the Sanderson Staff will collect the embossed passes at the doors.

PLEASE ALSO NOTE

PRINCIPAL'S HONOUR ROLL CRITERIA: Grade 12 Students who qualify for the Principal's Honour Roll must be enrolled in a minimum of six courses and must achieve a minimum overall average of 80%. These courses must be taken in the traditional classroom setting, during day school at St. John's College in the current academic year. One course in Religion must also be taken as part of this complement.

ONTARIO SCHOLAR CRITERIA: A student who obtains a total of at least 480 marks in any combination of ministry approved Grade 12 courses having a total of six credits, and who has been recommended by his or her principal for the Ontario Secondary School Diploma in either the current school year or the previous school year, may be designated an Ontario Scholar.
