- Completed 20 hours of Community Service (was due to Student Services by Jan. 28/21) It is your responsibility to ensure you have met these requirements. Please see your guidance counsellor for a credit check.

# **GRADUATION FEES & PHOTOS**

Graduation fees were collected in October 2020 through School Cash Online. All students who wish to participate in the graduation ceremony SHOULD HAVE PAID THEIR FEES AT THIS TIME. If fees were NOT paid, you WILL NOT be able to participate in the graduation ceremony. Should you fail to graduate, your fees—minus the \$25 grad photo sitting fee will be refunded. However, if you CHOOSE NOT to participate, refunds WILL NOT be given after MAY 3, 2021. Grad photos have also taken place (from Oct. 13-30, 2020). Grad photo re-takes dates are scheduled for MARCH 29 & 30, 2021. # PRINCIPAL'S HONOUR ROLL CRITERIA

Full-time, grade 12 students who qualify for the Principal's Honour Roll must be enrolled in a minimum of six courses and must achieve a minimum overall average of 80%. Courses must include a Religion course. These courses must be taken with the BHNCDSB in the current academic year from July 1, 2020 through to June 30, 2021.

# **ONTARIO SCHOLAR CRITERIA**

A student who obtains a total of at least **480 marks** in any combination of Ministry approved grade 12 courses, having a total of six grade 12 credits, and who has been recommended by his or her Principal for the Ontario Secondary School Diploma in either the current school year or the previous school year, may be designated as an Ontario Scholar.
