To register for grad, all potential graduates must complete a GRAD APPLICATION & pay their grad fee. The application and fee are to be completed through School Cash Online. This information is important as we must order a diploma for you from the Ministry of Education.

DEADLINE: NOVEMBER 12, 2021.

CREDIT ACCUMULATION

If you wish to **participate** in the Graduation Ceremony you must have:

- **30 credits, including 18 compulsory credits**
- **Completed 20 hours of Community Service** (due to Student Services by Jan. 31, 2022)
- **Fulfilling the EQAO LITERACY requirements set out by Ministry of Education**

has been **waived** for this year's graduates of 2021-2022.

GRADUATION FEES

PLEASE NOTE! Graduation Fees are to be paid through

Fees must be paid by November 12, 2021

The graduation fee is **\$80.00**. This amount includes the ceremony and **\$25 photo sitting fee**. The retreat and prom tickets are not included in this cost. If fees are not paid at this time you **WILL NOT** be able to participate in the graduation ceremony. Should you fail to graduate, your fee, minus the \$25.00 photo sitting fee, will be refunded. However if you **CHOOSE NOT** to participate—refunds minus the \$25.00 photo sitting fee, **WILL NOT** be given after **May 2, 2022**.

VALEDICTORIAN

Applications for Valedictorian were included in the 'Leaving the Nest' assembly package or can be found at sjconline.ca under Student Services / Grad Application Information. They must be submitted to Mrs. Ronson by **December 3, 2022**. Vote to take place on **February 22, 2022**.

PRINCIPAL'S HONOUR ROLL CRITERIA

Full-time, grade 12 students who qualify for the Principal's Honour Roll must be enrolled in a minimum of six courses and must achieve a minimum overall average of 80%. Courses must include a Religion course. These courses must be taken with the BHNCDSD in the current academic year from July 1, 2021 through to June 30, 2022.

ONTARIO SCHOLAR CRITERIA

A student who obtains a total of at least **480 marks** in any combination of 6 Ministry approved grade 12 courses, and who has been recommended by his or her Principal for the Ontario Secondary School Diploma in either the current school year or the previous school year, may be designated as an Ontario Scholar.
