Who can apply?

To apply to a SWAC program, you must be registered at a secondary school of the Brant Haldimand Norfolk Catholic District School Board or the Grand Erie District School Board. Out of school, but still need credits? Go to or call your home high school to register.

Three Easy Steps

- 1 Talk to a guidance counsellor to see if SWAC is right for you.
- 2 Complete an application form with help from your guidance counsellor.
- 3 Attend an intake interview with a college professor and teacher to review your plans.

HOW DO MY OPTIONS WORK?

SWAC Programs are delivered full-time at Fanshawe, Simcoe; Mohawk, Ohsweken; and Conestoga, Brantford.

Each college credit component successfully completed also generates one secondary credit towards your OSSD.

You have the opportunity to earn more secondary credits if you need them.

Half of your time is dedicated to the college component; the other half is your secondary component.
