

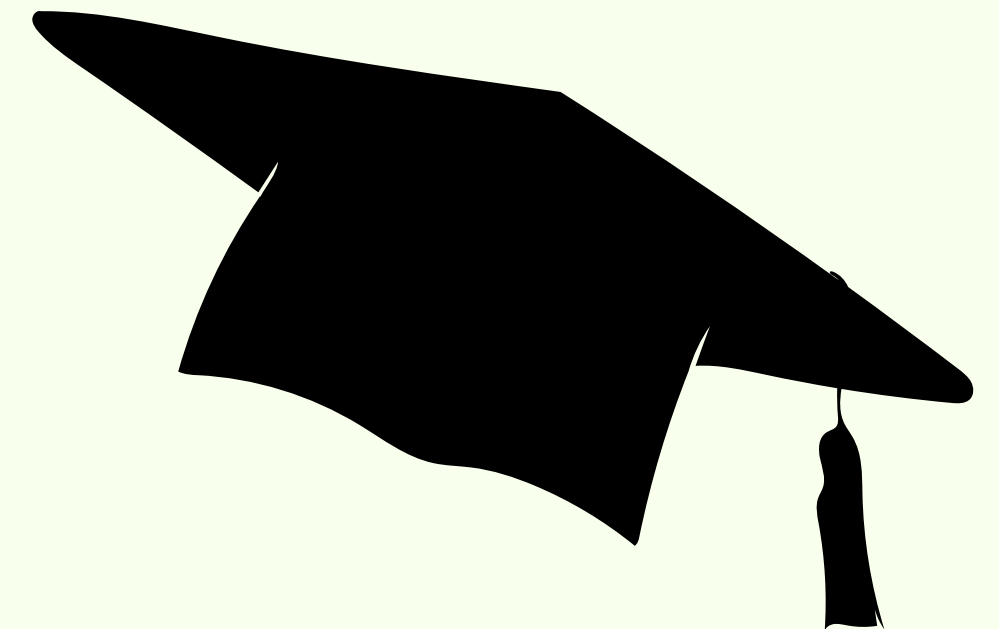

Upcoming Grad Events

- Grad Brunch - Tues. June 23 11am to 1:30pm
- Grad Rehearsal - Wed. June 24 9am *sharp*
- Grad Ceremony - Thurs. June 25 7pm



Grad Brunch

- 11am to 1:30pm - begin in the courtyard (or gym if raining), move to lower cafe for 11:30am, brunch ends by 1pm, grad package pick-up in upper cafe from 1-1:30pm
- DRESS CODE: business casual
- GRAD PACKAGE PICK-UP - upon completion of the brunch portion of the morning; MUST HAVE PHOTO I.D. (or a picture of it on your phone) & only you can pick up your grad package; you will sign for your grad package; no exceptions on any of these points
- PRINCIPAL'S HONOUR ROLL & ONTARIO SCHOLAR VERIFICATION - check in with Mr. MacKinlay outside the upper cafe to verify

For the Rehearsal:

1. **Begins promptly at 9am - give yourself time to park, pay & get to your seat**
2. **Assigned seating - check in with Mr. Lynch & Miss V upon entry**
3. **NO FOOD OR DRINKS (policy of Sanderson Centre) *no last minute Starbucks run and expect to come in with it & no to-go cups**
4. **Dress down - do not need to dress up; do not wear your grad gown and stole**
5. **You do NOT need a pass to get in for the rehearsal**
6. **We will go through everything to prepare you for the ceremony.**
7. **Should be done before noon.**
8. **Valedictorian must stay behind after to practice the address.**

Wear gown & stole, check in.

- Arrive on time. 6pm.
- Dress code under your gown - business casual or even dressier depending on your preference. NO SHORTS. Appropriate footwear for the occasion.
- You will not be admitted without your grad pass.
- Take care of your gown and stole. Take it out before the day of - ask a parent to steam or iron it - make sure it fits. Any issues email Mrs. Ronson asap. Wear the gown & stole to the Sanderson Centre or put it on when you arrive and have checked in.
- Reminder of the no food & drink policy - share with your parents.
- All grads & guests are asked to stay for the duration of the ceremony.
- Parents do not enter the same doors you do. Parents enter through the main doors on Dalhousie St. beginning at 6pm.
- It is first come, first serve for guest seating. There will be reserved signs in the accessibility boxes and possibly a few scattered in the auditorium.
- Grads have assigned seating - this will be reviewed at grad rehearsal.
- Leave all valuables at home. Nothing can be added to what you are wearing - just the gown and stole. Do not chew gum, wear headphones or airpods, carry anything with you. Phones should be off or on silent for the duration of the ceremony.

LAST REMINDERS FROM YOUR GUIDANCE TEAM:

- All **COMMUNITY HOURS** must be completed, submitted (with names and signatures). There are still some grads who have not yet completed this. Reminder - you won't graduate.
- **OPT-OUT** of e-learning forms need to be signed and submitted as well. If not - you will not graduate.
- **SHSM** students - please confirm with your SHSM teacher that you have all requirements met.
